POLICY DOCUMENTATION

BOWLING MACHINE SAFETY FORM – TO BE SIGNED BY ALL USERS

- 1/ I have been shown how to assemble and dismantle the bowling machine correctly
- 2/ I have been shown how to operate when feeding balls to a third party and when using the remote control for myself, with or without other members present
- 3/ I have been advised of other safety issues when feeding balls to a third party, such as awareness of batters attention and advising the batter of machine alterations (speed/accuracy/length etc)
- 4/ I have been advised to wear the appropriate safety equipment personally (pads, gloves, helmet, abdominal protector, thigh pads) when using the bowling machine and will advise other users similarly
- 5/ I am over eighteen years of age and accept full responsibility for any damage to the bowling machine whilst under my supervision

For the well being of all users of the bowling machine, it is important that all members are aware and recognize the value of safety measures that need addressing, prior during and after us of the bowling machine.
