You are travelling as a "team" so practicing, arriving and leaving as a team helps impress the opposition.

Please see attached the process that all festival and tournaments will follow regarding the COVID vaccination certificate process. As you will be aware all cricket festivals and tournaments across the South Island are classed as **'Events'** and will require vaccination passports (CVC). To make this process easier for all we have provided a link to register your details including CVCs prior to attending.

Your team coach/ manager will then provide you a wristband for you to wear for the duration of the event. This process has been implemented to minimise waiting time on arrival at the event and the frequency of you having to display your CVC during spot checks.
